COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL PROGRAMS

In-School Choral Program: "Sing" is a 40-minute presentation conducted by five members of our chorus that will: 1) demonstrate the potential of the human voice, 2) demonstrate the elements of music, and 3) introduce a variety of repertoire to the students. The presentation is interactive, engaging students whenever possible.
