The annual Young Artists Competition encourages young musicians to prepare solo repertoire to be performed with orchestra. Both instrumentalists and singers are encouraged to discover innovative and unusual repertoire that reflects the mission of the La Jolla Symphony & Chorus to perform groundbreaking, traditional and contemporary classical music. The competition is open to instrumentalists ages 14 to 26 and vocalists from the ages of 18 to 30 (at time of competition). Contestants must reside in San Diego or Baja California or have studied with a music teacher in San Diego or Baja California.

The LA JOLLA SYMPHONY & CHORUS YOUNG ARTISTS COMPETITION concentrates upon solo repertoire for solo instruments and orchestra. The instrumental division winner may be chosen to perform a solo work with the La Jolla Symphony. The encouragement to learn and present innovative repertoire is an extension of the philosophy of the La Jolla Symphony & Chorus to create and present varied and innovative programs. This competition requires that contestants include at least one selection composed from 1950 to the present.

REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants are required to provide an original copy of each selection for the judges. Digital printouts are acceptable with proof of purchase, i.e. a receipt.

1. Two of the three selections must have orchestral accompaniment. They may be single movement works or concerto movements. Three composers must be represented.
2. One selection must be a solo work for the instrument unaccompanied.

3. Two of the three selections must be performed from memory. At least one of these selections must date from 1950 to the present. Applicants are encouraged to consider music from contrasting periods. The choice of repertoire will be considered in the adjudication.
